The following guidelines outline expectations and policies for all exhibitors participating in the AAAP Annual Meeting. Please review carefully to ensure compliance and a successful exhibiting experience.

- AAAP does not accept organizations/companies that sell products and services on-site.
- AAAP does not provide exhibitors with an attendee list.
- AAAP does not provide exhibit floor plans to exhibitors in advance of the meeting.
- The exhibitor area will not be open for exhibitors to set up until November 11 at 7:00 am.

ACCME Guidelines

No commercial promotional materials shall be displayed or distributed in the same room immediately before, during, or after an educational activity certified for credit takes place. Representatives of commercial companies may attend an educational activity, but they may not engage in sales activities while in the room where the educational activity takes place.

Code of Conduct

AAAP expects all participants, including attendees, vendors, and staff, to conduct themselves in a professional manner that is welcoming to all participants. Participants should treat each other with mutual respect, well-being, and collegiality. All individuals agree to conduct themselves in a manner appropriate for healthcare professionals.

Participants will avoid any inappropriate actions or statements based on individual characteristics such as age, race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, gender identity, gender expression, marital status, nationality, political affiliation, ability status, educational background, or any other characteristic protected by law. Disruptive or harassing behavior of any kind will not be tolerated.

If an individual believes that this policy has been violated or breached, they shall notify AAAP's CEO to address the situation. AAAP reserves the right to remove meeting access for any individual violating this policy and will not be provided a refund.

By registering for this meeting, you agree to abide by the Code of Conduct Policy as described above.

Cancellations

Refunds will not be issued under any circumstances, regardless of the date of cancellation or reduction of exhibit space. AAAP will be entitled to retain or collect 100% of the Exhibitor's total contract obligation if the Exhibitor cancels or reduces their exhibit space.
