This award is given to rising PGY3s residents **nominated by their residency directors** (PGY3s starting in July 2026) enrolled in programs related to the treatment of substance use disorders and co-occurring psychiatric disorders. This award is designed to help direct PGY3 Awardees to valuable AAAP opportunities and encourage their attendance at our 37th Annual Meeting and Scientific Symposium.

Nomination Criteria:

- PGY3 Resident (starting in July 2026)
- All awardees are formally nominated by their residency directors
- Award may only be received once

Recipient Award:

- Award recipients will receive free registration at this year's Annual Meeting and Scientific Symposium in Memphis, being held November 12-15th.
- Winners will also receive a plaque during the Awards and Recognition Ceremony on Saturday, November 14th.
