



Onsite FAQs:

Registration FAQ

Q: What are the hours/location of the registration desk?

A: The registration desk will be located at the Mezzanine Level throughout the Annual Meeting. Below are the hours of the registration desk.

- 2 pm – 9 pm: Wednesday, November 11, 2026
- 7 am – 5 pm: Thursday, November 12, 2026
- 7 am – 4 pm: Friday, November 13, 2026
- 7:30 am – 4 pm: Saturday, November 14, 2026
- 7 am – 9:30 am: Sunday, November 15, 2026

Q: Can I cancel my registration?

A: No, our cancellation policy only allows a 50% refund before September 1, 2026. After that, no refunds will be honored, but substitutions are allowed at any time.

Q: What if I arrive late at the Annual Meeting?

A: You can still check in if you arrive late, you can find the registration hours on our app but please be aware that some sessions may have already started.

Q: What are guests allowed to attend?

A: Guests are only to attend the Fellowship forum, Poster Walk, Award Ceremony, and Reception and have access to all lunches and drink tickets. If guests would like to attend additional sessions, they will need to register for the whole Annual Meeting.

Sessions FAQ

Q: Can I make any changes to my presentation?

A: No, presenters are not allowed to make any content changes to their presentation, but they can review their presentation at the Annual Meeting registration desk in the morning before their session.

Q: Can presenters use their laptops to present at the Annual Meeting?

A: No, all presentations have been submitted and approved. We will have your slides uploaded to the AV laptop in the room and ready for you when you arrive. You will not use your laptop.

Q: If a poster presenter cannot be present, can they still have their poster on the board?

A: No, but they can have a person present in their place if they can't attend. The poster will still be published in the *AJA*.

Q: What time/day can poster presenters start setting up their posters?

A: Poster presenters can set up between 4:00 PM to 6:30 PM on Wednesday, November 11th, 2026.

Q: What time is the poster walk?

A: The poster walk is on Sunday, November 15th, from 8:00 AM to 9:30 AM.

Lunch & Drink Tickets FAQ

Q: Where can I get my lunch and drink tickets?

A: Tickets can be found in your name badge. You will have 3 lunch tickets that are the same color and 1 drink ticket for a drink at the welcome reception on Thursday.

Exhibitor FAQ

Q: I do not have my exhibitor table number.

A: Please check your email from us, you should have received information from our staff.

Q: Can exhibitors attend the sessions?

A: Yes, the primary contact for the exhibit can attend the sessions. Additional guests at the table only have access to the lunch provided.

Q: Can exhibitors attend the reception?

A: Yes, exhibitors are allowed to attend receptions at the Annual Meeting.

Trainees and Awardees FAQ

Q: What are good sessions for trainees to attend?

A: All trainees are encouraged to attend as many sessions as possible.

Q: I am not ready to join a fellowship, but can I attend the fellowship meeting?

A: Yes, you can still attend to learn about what the group does.

Q: Are there any trainee-specific events at the Annual Meeting?

A: Yes, we have events just for trainees; we have the trainee mingle and the scavenger hunt. Please refer to the app for more information. We also have the Trainee Awardees Event, but this is only meant for the awardees.

Q: What time does the award ceremony start and when should awardees arrive?

A: The award ceremony starts at 6:30 PM on Saturday, and all awardees are expected to be at the Ballroom 15 minutes early to find their seats.

Q: Is there a place for trainees to meet up?

A: Thursday through Saturday, there will be a room noted in the schedule where trainees can meet up.

Q: What do I need to track for my reimbursement form?

A: Make sure you are keeping all your expense receipts and make sure you are meeting the Pre Deim requirement for the expense that you can claim. Please refer back to your acceptance letter for more information or reach out to membership@aaap.org for more information.

Bingo & Scavenger Hunt FAQ

Q: How can I participate in the Networking Bingo?

A: Attendees can pick up the bingo card at the registration desk starting on Friday, and the first 5 people who returned their card fully blacked out between Friday and Saturday will receive a gift.

Q: What are the rules of Networking Bingo?

A: Attendees can scan the QR code on the bingo card bonus space to find the rule or by clicking on “info” on the conference App.

Q: How can I participate in the Scavenger Hunt?

A: The scavenger hunt is only meant for our trainees. If you are a trainee, you should have received information from staff on how to participate. You can also find the rules by clicking on “info” on the conference App.

App FAQ

Q: How can I download the app?

A: Visit your app store, either Google Play or Apple Store – search for **AAAP Conference** or scan the QR code at the registration desk. If you have the app from a previous year, you may need to delete and redownload to update the conference information to the current year.

Q: What login information do I use to access the app?

A: Use the same username and password that you use for the conference website and your membership. If you encounter any issues, please try resetting your password and check your spam folder for any emails.

Q: Do I need to log into the conference app?

A: You can view the conference agenda without logging in. However, to create a personalized agenda by saving sessions you’re interested in, you will need to log in. Logging in also enables you to chat with presenters and other attendees at the Annual Meeting.
