

Medical Student Education Award Guidelines

Deadline: June 23rd, 2025

Description:

Awards for Medical Student Education (AMSE) recognizes an Addiction Psychiatrist in clinical practice who demonstrates a sustained record of outstanding contributions to medical student education in addiction psychiatry.

Eligibility Criteria:

- MD/DO psychiatrist in active clinical practice
- AAAP Current Member
- Past recipients of this award will be re-eligible in 5 years.

Award Selection Criteria:

- Significant and sustained (at least 2 years) contributions to medical student education in Addiction Psychiatry
- Record of achievement in one or more of the following categories:
 - o Development/implementation of innovative teaching methods.
 - o Development/implementation of new educational programs.
 - o Development/implementation of novel clinical training experiences.
 - Development of curricular materials.
 - Course design and administration.
 - Clinical supervision and bedside teaching.
 - Mentoring students in the classroom or clinical setting.

Submission Process:

- Complete the application in its entirety.
 - NOTE: Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.
- Required materials:
 - o Curriculum Vitae (CV) in PDF format.
 - o Personal statement emphasizing evidence of award criteria.
 - At least one and no more than two letters of recommendation from any of the following:
 - Former learners (students or residents)
 - Colleagues or supervisors
- Acceptance of submission all nominees will be contacted by mid-July.

Recipient Award:

- Award recipients will receive free registration to this year's Annual Meeting and Scientific Symposium.
- Winners will also receive a plaque during the award ceremony.
